KES Background

The Knox Environment Society is a community based, not for profit, group that has three main objectives.

- 1. To foster within the community, interest in the Knox environment.**
- 2. To provide opportunities for local environmentalists to meet and exchange ideas.**
- 3. To undertake such projects, studies and activities as will further the interests of conservation and natural history.**

As part of our activities we propagate native plants that grow within the Knox area (indigenous) and make them available to businesses, the Knox Council and residents.

Plants can be obtained in two different ways:

KES Community Nursery

The nursery is Intended for retail sales and is run by volunteers. It is located next to the FTG library in the Ferntree Gully Reserve on Burwood Hwy (opposite Aldi) and is open on Sundays and Thursdays from 10am to 4pm.

A range of local plants is available and stock changes monthly - so you never know what surprises await you. Only a small number of each plant is kept on site and are used mainly by Knox residents for their gardens. The nursery is staffed by volunteers who are happy to give advice and suggestions to patrons. Most plants are sold in tubes as this is the best way to plant natives as they grow and adapt more quickly than potted plants. Operation Revegetation

This is the commercial, wholesale arm of KES that grows large numbers of plants mainly for councils as well as businesses. The plants can be obtained in a variety of forms. Most come in tubes but larger plants, including trees over 2 metres, can be provided in pots. Operation Revegetation also has some native plants that are not found in the local environment which are not invasive and grow well in our dry, nutrient poor soils.
